- Ensure, based on pilot and all other relevant information, daily problem analysis and problem solving;
- Ensure briefing and debriefing of pilots and Maintenance Lead;
- Ensure that PRF (preflight check) is performed;
- Ensure, in cooperation with NHV Supply Chain, Store and support services that the necessary maintenance material and spare parts are present on site at the planned moment: material in service car, consumables, limited service stock, work material, material needed for normal day-to-day line maintenance, exceptional material supplied for exceptional line maintenance or small repair tasks;
- Report daily on the maintenance situation to the Maintenance Lead.
