Key Responsibilities

- Plan, conduct and follow up on audits in accordance with the approved Compliance Monitoring Programme.
- Perform scheduled and unscheduled audits across Part-145, Part-147 and CAMO organisations.
- Verify compliance with aviation regulations, company procedures and approved exposition requirements.
- Assess the implementation and effectiveness of corrective actions and monitor their closure.
- Identify systemic issues, emerging compliance risks and opportunities for improvement.
- Support risk-based audit planning and compliance monitoring activities.
- Prepare audit reports, compliance monitoring records, audit schedules and follow-up reports.
- Support mandatory recurring reporting and follow up on Company Authorisation Card (CAC) systems.
- Participate in authority, supplier and customer audits.
- Support the integration of Compliance Monitoring and Safety Management Systems (SMS).
- Contribute to safety investigations, risk assessments and the identification of safety trends.
- Promote a positive safety and reporting culture throughout the organisation.
- Monitor regulatory developments affecting Part-145, Part-147 and CAMO activities.
- Support procedural improvements and exposition amendments.
- Provide compliance guidance to operational departments and promote standardisation across NHV locations.

- Minimum 5 years of relevant experience within a maintenance and/or continuing airworthiness organisation.
- Recognised aviation technical qualification (Bachelor's degree or equivalent through experience).
- Strong knowledge of Part-145, Part-147, CAMO, Compliance Monitoring, Human Factors and Safety Management Systems.
- Previous auditing experience is an advantage.
- Good IT skills, including Microsoft Office applications.
- Experience with ERP and compliance management systems such as Rusada and Q-Pulse is a plus.
- Extensive knowledge of EASA and/or UK CAA regulations.

- Knowledge of Dutch and/or French is an advantage.
